We are seeking a dedicated, personable Community Foot Patrol to join our team.

Program Summary

The Community Foot Patrol is responsible for providing a street level, uniformed presence in the Exchange District which offers a variety of assistance to users of the area.

The Community Foot Patrol will liaise with the BIZ membership and other related organizations such as the Winnipeg Police Service on safety matters pertaining to the Exchange District. The Community Foot Patrol reports to the Operations Manager and works closely with the Program's volunteer personnel as well as other full-time and seasonal staff.

Job Summary

- Have successfully complete the Exchange District BIZ Foot Patrol training program
- Have sound knowledge of the BIZ safety program policies, goals and objectives
- Have in-depth knowledge and complete familiarity with downtown and Exchange District safety issues and trends

- Perform data collection, note-taking and create status and incident reports
- Help to maintain accurate filing and administration related to the foot patrol program
- Help to maintain good working condition of foot patrol equipment, uniforms and supplies
- Help to maintain a clean and organized office environment
- Assist with district cleanliness and graffiti removal operations from time to time
- In consultation with the Operations Manager, make recommendations and suggestions on program improvement
- Perform other duties as required
